TAILGATING RULES AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Tailgate will take place on the visitor side parking lot (East Stadium Lot).
- 2. Parents must follow all Katy Independent School District policies during this event. No Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, Pets, etc. Please refer to www.katyisd.org for complete rules and regulations.
- 3. <u>Glass is not allowed</u>. Please use plastic cups and bottles, or aluminum cans. Coolers with drinks are permitted. Remember to bring plenty of water and stay hydrated!
- 4. Food Vendors will be on hand to support KYF®, but we also encourage you to prepare food in your tailgate areas.
- 5. <u>Gas</u> and <u>Propane</u> barbeque grills are acceptable to use. Coal/Briquettes are <u>NOT</u> acceptable for tailgating. No burning of wood is allowed (i.e. <u>NO PIT SMOKERS</u>). <u>NO OPEN FIRES ARE ALLOWED!</u> If gas/propane grilling is conducted in your location you must have a current fire extinguisher within 10 feet of grill, and the grill must be manned by an adult at all times.
- 6. Drippings from gas/propane grills must not fall onto the ground. Please use drip pans (Water heater catch pans work well) to catch drippings.
- 7. Propane: Ensure connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- 8. Generators are allowed, however, fuel must be stored in approved metal safety cans with spring loaded lid and flashback guard.
- 9. All trash must be picked up and thrown away prior to ceremonies. Trash receptacles will be placed in the tailgate area for your convenience.
- 10. All tents and chairs must be picked up and stowed prior to ceremonies.
- 11. KISD and KYF® are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 12. Please remember to be courteous to other KYF® teams and follow all instructions from KYF® Board Members, Volunteers, Contractor Staff and KISD Law Enforcement Officers.
